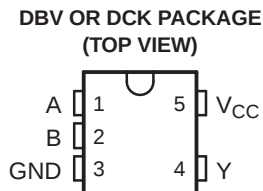

The SN74LVC1G08 performs the Boolean function $Y = A \bullet B$ or $Y = \overline{A} + \overline{B}$ in positive logic.

This device is fully specified for partial-power-down applications using I_{off} . The I_{off} circuitry disables the outputs, preventing damaging current backflow through the device when it is powered down.

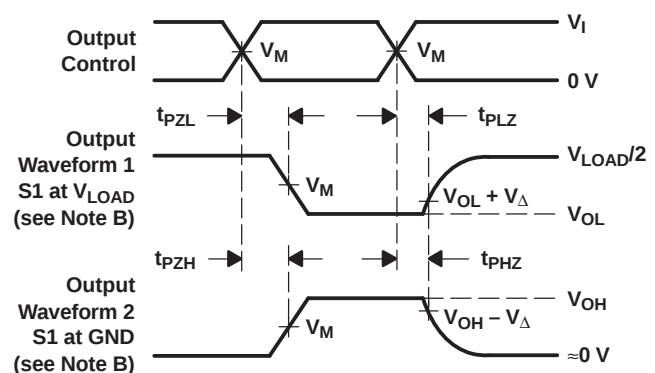
VOLTAGE WAVEFORMS

INVERTING AND NONINVERTING OUTPUTS

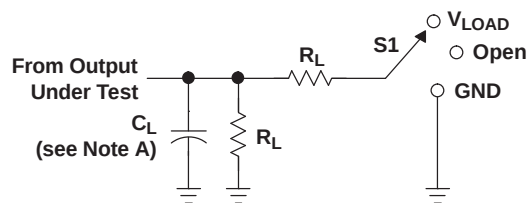


VOLTAGE WAVEFORMS

Figure 1. Load Circuit and Voltage Waveforms

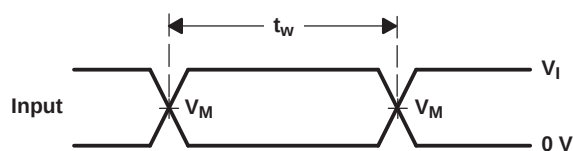

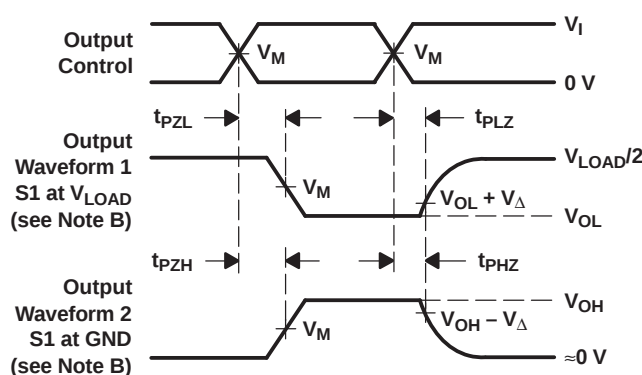
VOLTAGE WAVEFORMS

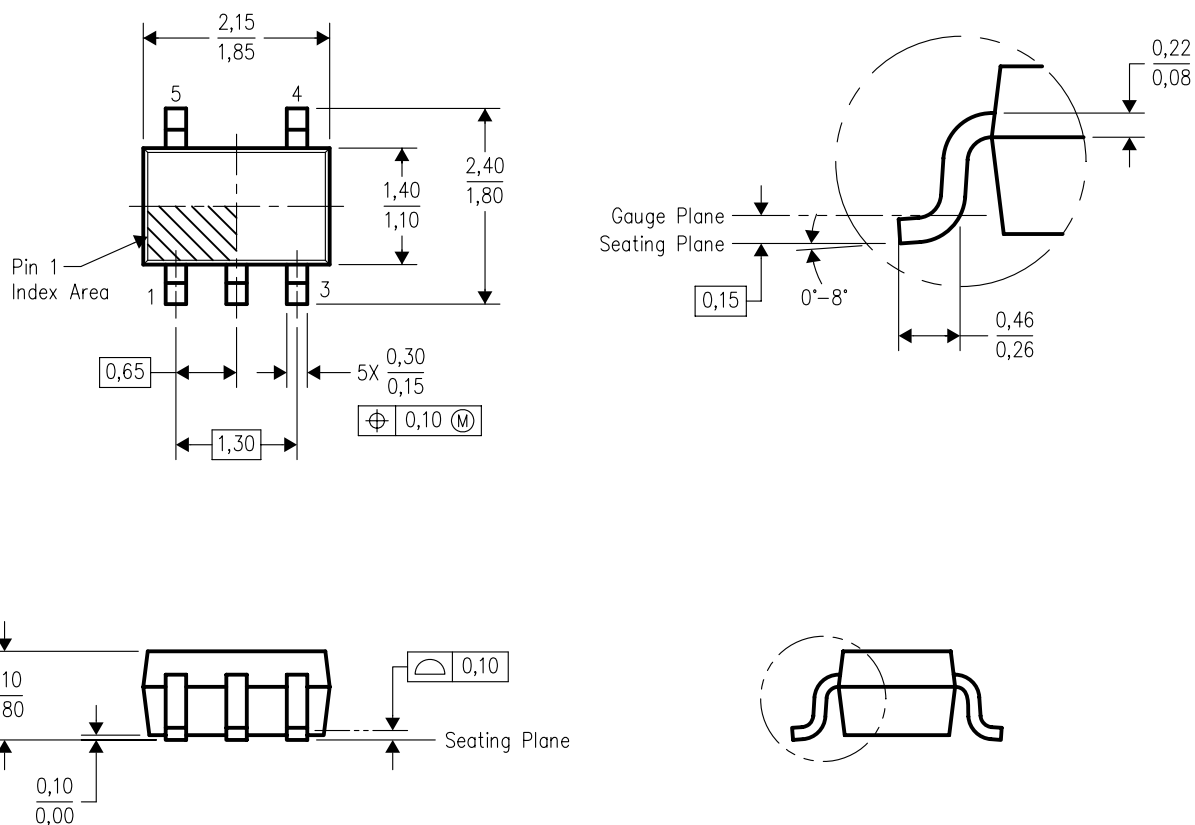

PLASTIC SMALL-OUTLINE PACKAGE

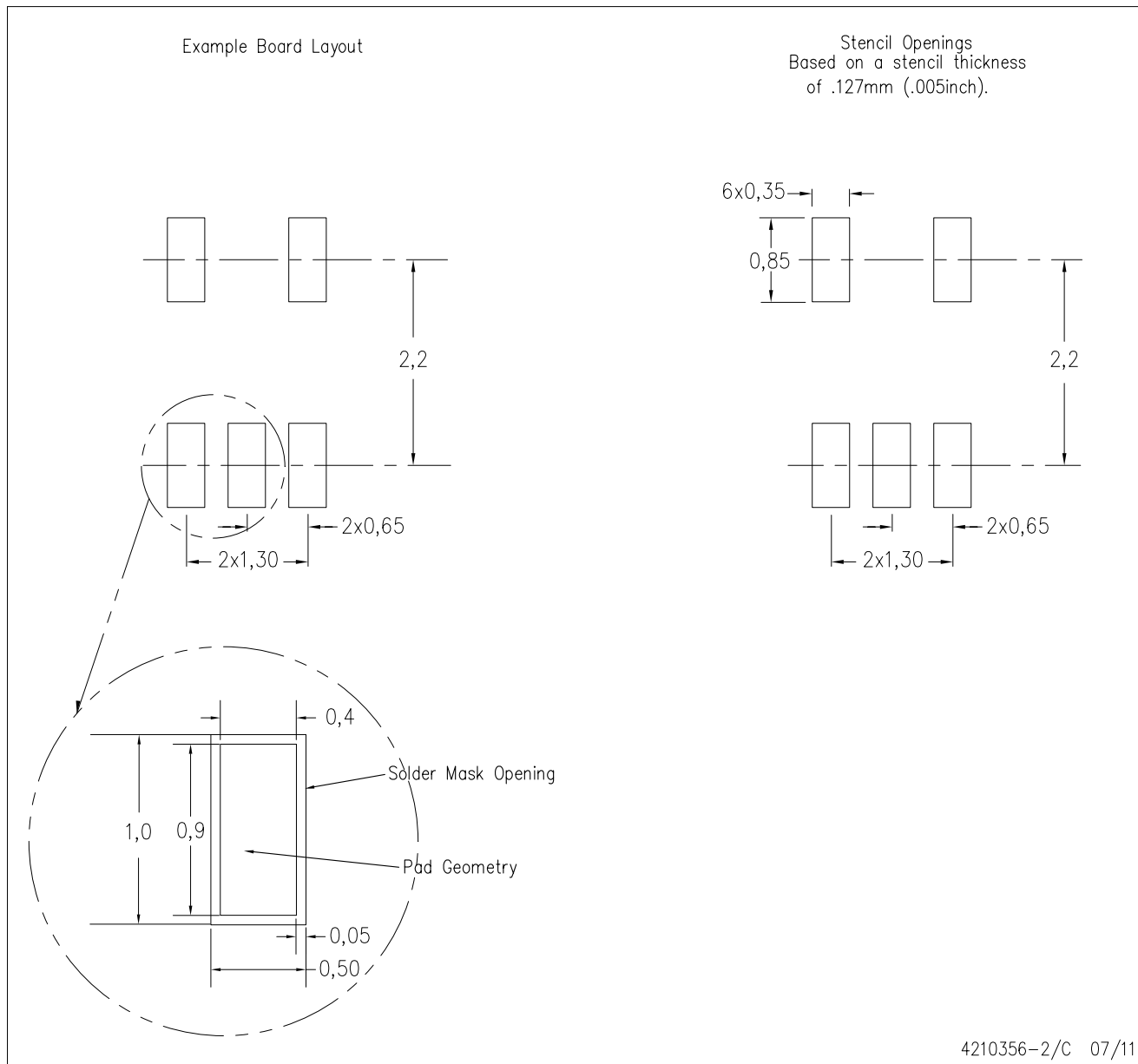
