I installed this memory into an old Fujitsu Lifebook S6231 that had only 512MB. Windows XP was dog slow on this machine, and the hard drive would thrash with every operation. The upgrade to 2GB works great, but I'm a little disappointed in the speed improvement. It doesn't thrash any more, but only a few things are significantly faster. The rest is about the same. I'm not sure it was worth the extra \$45 to upgrade to 2GB instead of 1GB. At the very least, I
